Title:	English-Speaking Mentors
Objective:	To support the process of settlement to newcomers to Canada by pairing them up with English speaking volunteers.
Qualifications:	 Fluent in English (You do not have to be a native speaker) Sensitivity to cultural diversity and a non-judgmental attitude Able to work with people from different age groups
Responsibilities:	 Help mentees to practice their English in an informal setting Assist mentees to gain/improve their English conversational skills Abide by Centre's confidentiality policy Availability to meet four times a month for a least one hour
Training/Support:	 Orientation to Working Women Community Centre On-going support from supervisor Information about free events and activities
Commitment:	 There is no minimum time commitment, but we advise volunteers to commit for at least 3 months Work hours: Minimum requirement of 4 hours per month; participants will decide when and how often they would meet
Benefits:	 Letter of reference upon successful completion of volunteer activity The opportunity to share cultural experiences The possibility to get free tickets for cultural events Networking The alternative of learning a second language; however the program focuses in supporting the mentees' needs first
